Do you need help understanding the Norwegian Tax system, or with filling out your Norwegian Tax return? In this online seminar, held by tax lawyers, we will assist you with this. ## **Taxes 2025 – Important information**

#### Make sure to check your new tax card for 2025:

- If you have a permanent ID number, your tax card will be automatically updated by the tax administration with the information they have from 2024 you still need to login at <a href="Skatteetaten.no">Skatteetaten.no</a> to check that the information is correct.
- If you have a D-number (temporary ID number) you need to login at <u>Skatteetaten.no</u> and order a new tax card.

Remember that you should update your information if there are any changes throughout the year that might affect your tax card, like income, loans, marriage, etc. You can read more about this here.

**Have you been kicked out of the PAYE scheme for previous years?** Make sure that you have a tax return for that year so you can verify the information that the tax administration has about you. If you don't have one, you can contact the tax administration using the <u>form RF-1306</u> asking for it.

# Winter holidays

For those of you with children in school, the winter holidays for schools in Bergen are from February 24<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>. This does not include kindergarten or after-school care.
