Føring av arbeidstid som normalt fra 15.09.20

– men kjernetiden er fortsatt opphevet

Fra 15. september avslutter UiB den automatiske tidsregistreringen i Min Tid. Det betyr at reglene for tidsregistrering gjelder som normalt, og at alle som har fleksitid igjen skal føre faktisk arbeidet tid. Merk at reglene om kjernetid fortsatt er opphevet i staten ([lenke til avtale sentrale parter](#)). Dette for å legge til rette for at ansatte kan arbeide hjemmefra og til ulike tider av dagen av hensyn til smittevern.

Normal registration of working hours from 15.09.20

-but the core working hours (kjernetid) is still repealed

As of 15. September, UiB will end the automatic registration of working hours in Min Tid. This means that the rules for registration apply as normal, and that everyone who have flexi-time, must start to register the actual work time again. Note that the rules regarding core time are still repealed in the public sector. This is to enable employees to work from home, and at different times of the day for the sake of infection control.



Covid19 har naturligvis skapt problemer for årets kull av norske Fulbrightstipendiater - som for alle andre - og vi har tilimpet så godt vi kan innenfor rådende restriksjoner; noen har vært nødt til å trekke seg, noen reiser ut først i januar, og andre har valgt å utsette oppholdet til neste år.

Men nå håper vi på bedre tider, ser fremover, og minner om søknadsfristen for Fulbrightstipend til USA for det akademiske året 2021-22: **01.10.2020**.

Ca. 40 stipender tilbys, i alle fagfelt på Master, PhD, post-doc og seniorforsker nivå. Stipendbeløpene er ikke fastsatt, men vil variere fra NOK 50.000 til NOK 200.000.
