Hei Dere,

Basert på den marine satsningens prosess med å styrke oss på plastområdet, er BIO i ferd med å ansette to Ilerstillinger, samt en stipendiat inn mot problematikken. Jeg synes det er veldig bra at BIO nå tydelig vil bidra til kunnskap omkring de biologiske effektene av plast i det marine miljø.

UiBs satsning på klima og energiomstilling har også resultert i midler i retning BIO. Universitetsstyret har allokert midler til en satsning som skal resultere i et senter for bærekraftig arealbruk, basert på BIO. BIO er åpenbart høyst relevant her, både på terrestrisk og marin. Basert på midlene vi får er vi i ferd med å lyse ut et professorat. Bærekraftig arealbruk er i aller høyeste grad et tverrfaglig tema, så satsningen innebærer også midler til samfunnsfaglige miljø ved UiB.

Ledergruppen hadde et konstruktivt og godt seminar på Solstrand i forrige uke. Fokuset var på hvordan vi kan fungere bedre som ledergruppe, både i oss selv og for hele BIO, hvilke saker vi skal fokusere på i tiden framover. En av dem er å utarbeide en ny strategisk plan for BIO. Vi skal snart initiere prosesser som skal fokusere på forskning, utdanning, nye faglige områder og administrasjon og ledelse. Mer info om dette kommer snart.

Generiske ferdigheter: instituttet skal innen 1 mars kartlegge og systematisere undervisningsaktiviteten rettet mot generiske ferdigheter (skriving, kommunikasjon, samarbeid, kritisk tenkning, etc). Det er viktig at emneansvarlige kaster seg over dette og bidrar i denne prosessen (som faggruppe-lederne styrer), slik at vi får en komplett oversikt som vi kan jobbe videre ut fra. Målet er selvsagt at vår undervisningsaktivitet på dette feltet skal bli mer helhetlig og systematisk, og at vi skal bli enda bedre i vår undervisning innen generiske ferdigheter.

Uttellingen på våre søknader fra NFR har vært mindre enn vi kunne ønske, men før nyttår fikk Sigurd Handeland, Nils-Kåre, Hans Tore, Tom Ole støtte til prosjekter, og vi er glad for at Anne-Gro nå også har fått tilslag i Marinforsk. Gratulerer så mye til alle sammen. Veldig vel-fortjent.

Vi er snart klare for å re-starte vår seminarserie, og først ut er Fergal O'Farrell, 5. februar. Jeg håper mange finner tid og lyst til å delta. Det er viktig.

Jeg minner også om BIO-dagen den 20 mars. Invitasjon til påmelding kommer snart, og snakk med faggruppelider så snart som mulig om du vil gi et faglig bidrag. Dette blir givende og spennende, og vi skal spise og danse.

Based on the of the Marine Initiative's process of strengthening our capacity in the field of plastics pollution, BIO is in the process of hiring two adjunct professors/associate professors as well as a PhD-fellow, within this field. I am very pleased that BIO will now make a very explicit contribution to the knowledge about the biological effects of plastics in the marine environment.

UiB's focus on the climate and energy shift has also resulted in funding for BIO. The University Board has allocated funds into a venture aimed to establish a center for sustainable land use, to be anchored at BIO. BIO is obviously highly relevant here, both in terrestrial and marine. With the allocated funds, we are about to announce a professorship. Sustainable land use is, to the highest degree, an interdisciplinary theme, so the initiative also include funds for the social science environment at UiB.

The leadership group had a constructive and constructive and successful seminar at Solstrand last week. The focus was on how we can function better as a management team to the benefit of the entire BIO and which issues we will be focussing on in the near future. One of them is to prepare a new strategic plan for the BIO. We will soon initiate processes that will focus on research, education, new academic areas and administration and management. More info will follow soon.

Generic skills: By March 1, the institute will map and systematize teaching activities aimed at generic skills (writing, communication, collaboration, critical thinking, etc). It is important that the course managers tackle this task head on and contribute to the process (which is managed by the subject group leaders), so that we get a complete overview which we can base our further work on. The goal is, of course, that our teaching activities in this field should become more comprehensive and systematic, and that we should become even better in our teaching in generic skills.

The outcome of our applications to the NRC has been less than we could have wished for this time, but before Christmas Sigurd Handeland, Nils-Kåre, Hans Tore and Tom Ole received support for projects, and we are glad that Anne-Gro has now also received a grant within the Marine Research call. Congratulations to everyone - very well-deserved.

We are soon ready to restart our seminar series, and first out is Fergal O'Farrell, February 5th. I hope many find the time and wish to participate. It is important.

I also remind you that the BIO Day takes place March 20. The invitation to sign up will be coming soon. Get in touch with your subject group leader (faggruppelider) as soon as possible if you want to make a professional contribution (talk or poster). The event will be rewarding and exciting, and we will eat and dance.



### How can we ensure that research and innovation contribute to sustainable development?

**Siri Granum Carson**, director of NTNU Oceans & **Jens Kristian Fosse**, Vice Dean for Innovation and head of the Mohn Center for Innovation and Regional Development, HVL

The UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) provide an indication of the direction in which development must move, but how can we ensure that research and innovation support these goals? 'RRI' stands for **Responsible Research and Innovation** and centers around how research and innovation can be more focused on solving major global societal challenges. At the same time, we should not focus exclusively on global agendas, because the SDGs cannot be achieved without change at the local and regional scales.

**Siri Granum Carson** is Director of NTNU Oceans and Associate Professor on the Program for Applied Ethics at NTNU. She is the project manager for AFINO - a national, virtual center for responsible innovation and corporate social responsibility in Norway.

**Jens Kristian Fosse** is the Vice Dean for Innovation at the Faculty of Engineering and Natural Sciences and head of the Mohn Center for Innovation and Regional Development at Western Norway University of Applied Sciences. He is affiliated with the project 'Capacity Lift for Sustainable and Innovative Seafood Production' (KABIS).

Both Carson and Fosse are adjunct professors affiliated with the UNESCO Chair for Sustainable Heritage and Environmental Management at BIO.
