Deep Sea Biology research group



Hei,

my name is Katharina and I'm joining the BIO department as a Postdoctoral Researcher in the Deep Sea Biology research group. I will be working with Ida Helene Steen and Runar Stokke and will be an associated researcher to the Deep Sea-Sequence project. My research will focus on heterotrophic bacterial communities in arctic hydrothermal sediments. I will isolate and grow novel heterotrophic microorganisms that play potential roles in carbon cycling in hydrothermal sediments. The uptake mechanisms will be identified and I will point out how the food-webs are constructed that degrade the complex carbon compounds. Enrichment cultures with various substrates such as cellulose or chitin will be examined for the presence of polysaccharide degradation genes identified in previously available metagenomes. Prior to arriving in Bergen, I lived in Hamburg, Germany where I completed my PhD this year. My PhD focused on autotrophic bacterial communities at hydrothermal vents of the MAR and the Kermadec Arc. I analyzed the microbial communities and their functionalities and then focused on the cultivation and isolation of hydrogen oxidizing microorganisms. I am excited to be part of BIO and continue to focus on cultivating microorganisms that have not yet been cultivated to shed a little more light on the great potential of the deep sea.

Bergen International Film Festival will take place from October 20th to October 28th.

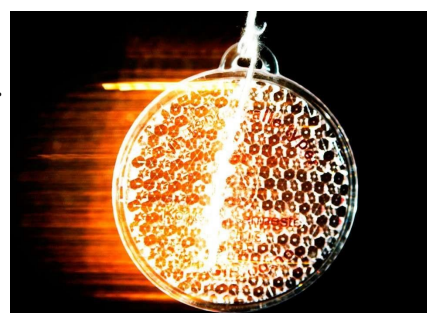

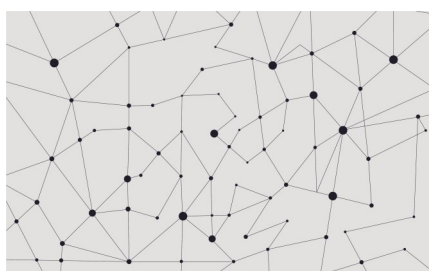
