The PhD result shall consist of an artistic result as well as material that documents artistic reflection. The artistic result is to be an independent work that meets international standards in terms of level and ethical requirements within the subject area. (Regulations § 10-1)

Both the artistic result and the material that document artistic reflection are subjects of the final assessment of the committee. In the PhD programme the material communicating reflection can either be presented to the assessment committee before the presentation of the artistic result, or the reflection can be finalized at the time of public presentation of the artistic result. If the candidate wants the committee to have access to material presenting artistic reflection before the presentation of the artistic result, this material must be delivered to the assessment committee no later than 4 weeks before the public presentation of the artistic result.

Whereas the Norwegian Artistic Research Fellowship Programme allows delivery of the artistic reflection after presentation of the artistic result, this is not an option in the new PhD programme.
