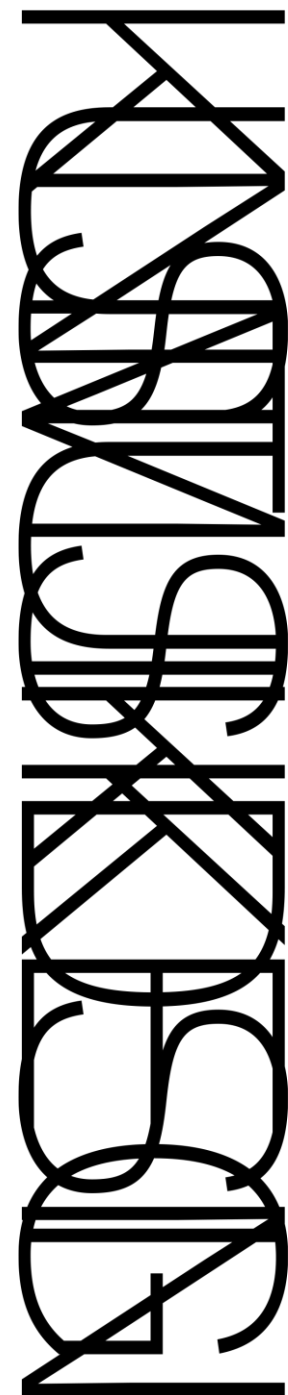
Aim:

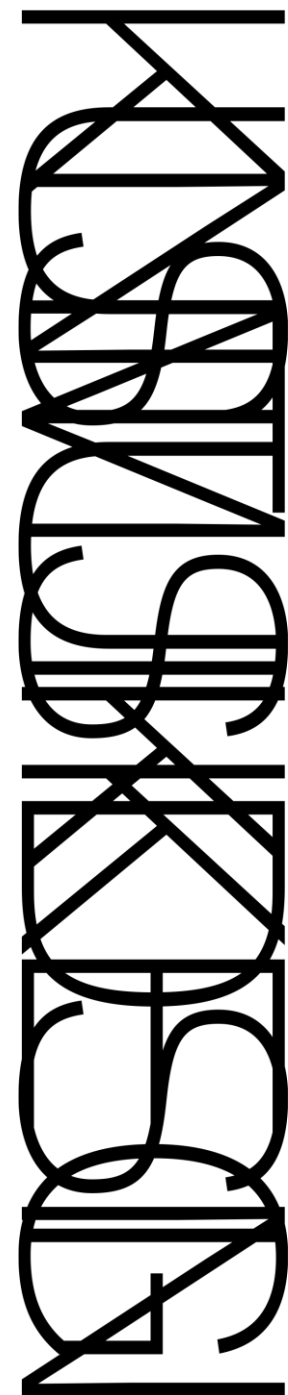
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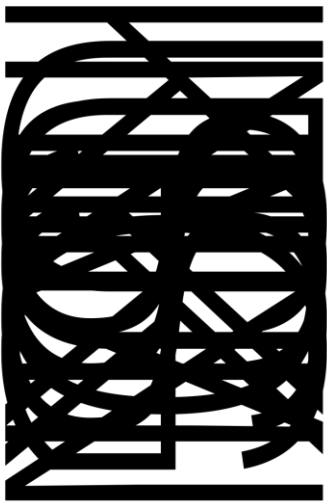

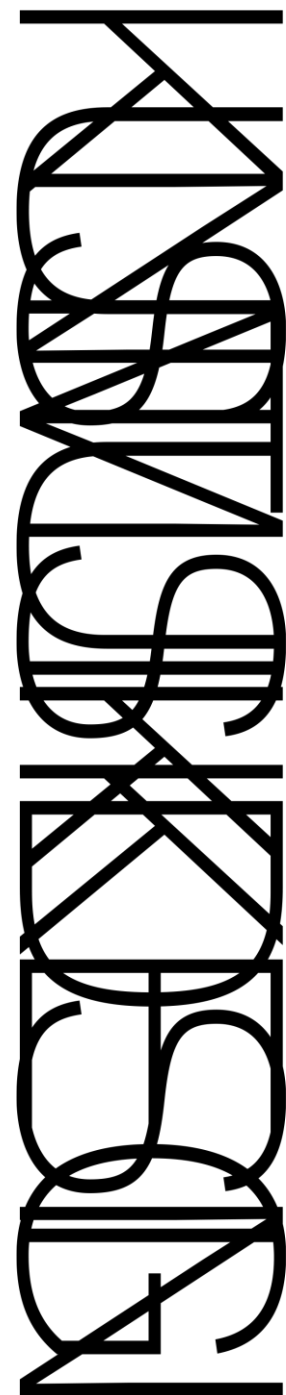

**Faglig and administrative:**

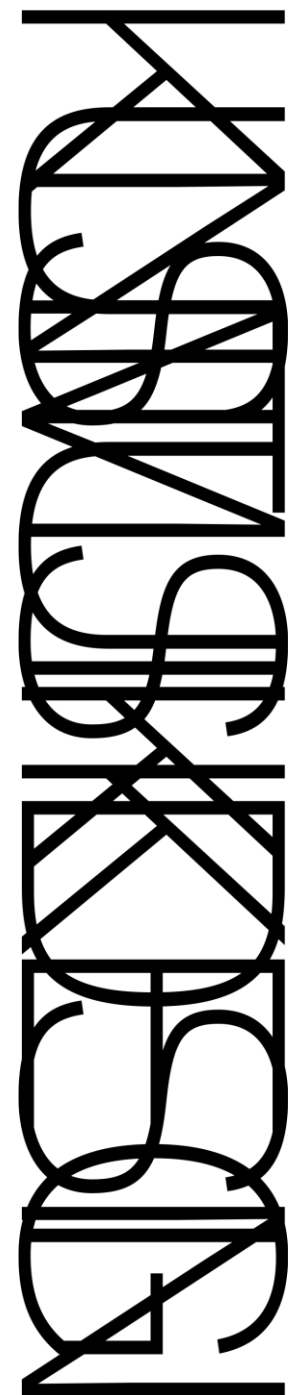
- Researchers/artists, PhD candidates, committee members (as us), administrative staff, and leaders

*Security and empowerment of all our staff members*

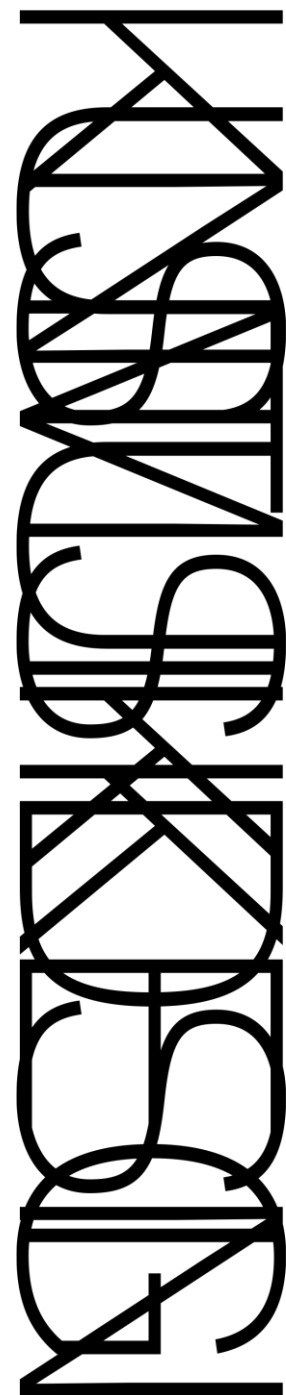

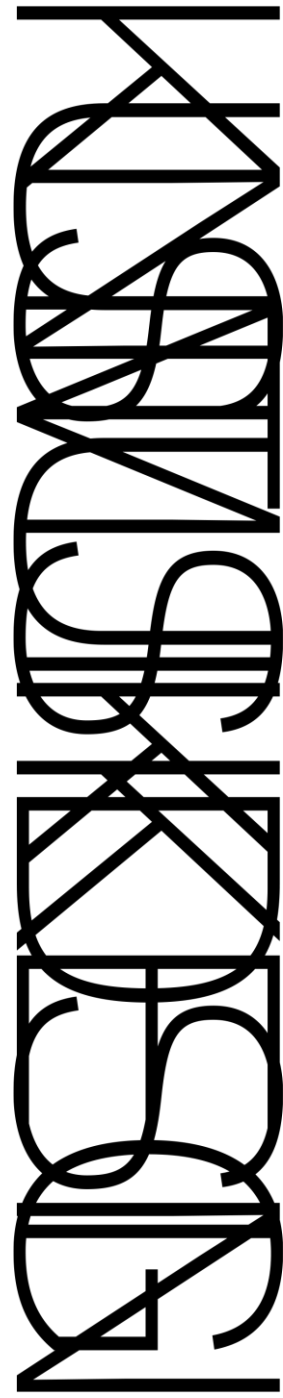
- Obstacles for approaching research ethics are also practical:

(UHR-KDA)

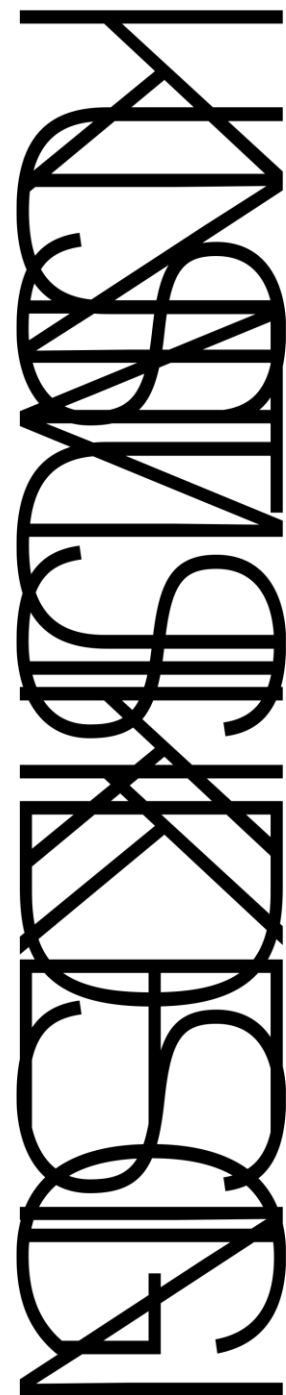


A conclusion of our three seminars is that

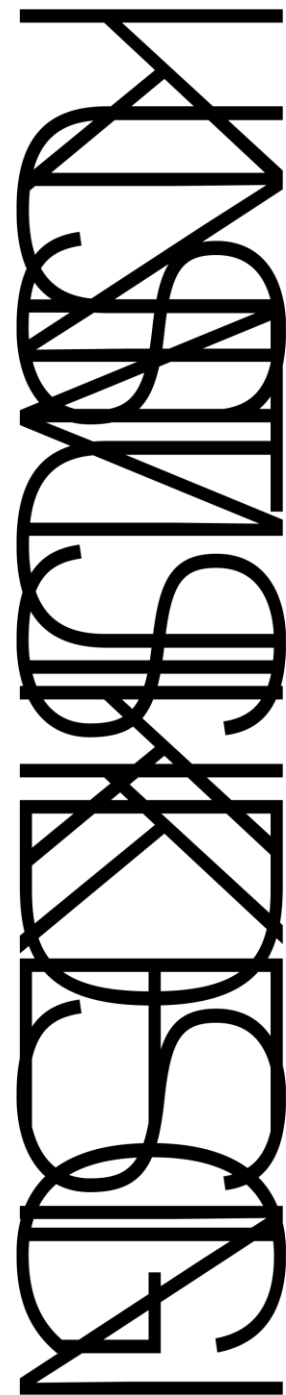
The following are suggestions to be implemented by the Dean and the department leaders:

## Courses:

Should be offered regularly and across the faculty, for all departments,

Should be based on a discursive approach, ethics applied on projects and relevant cases

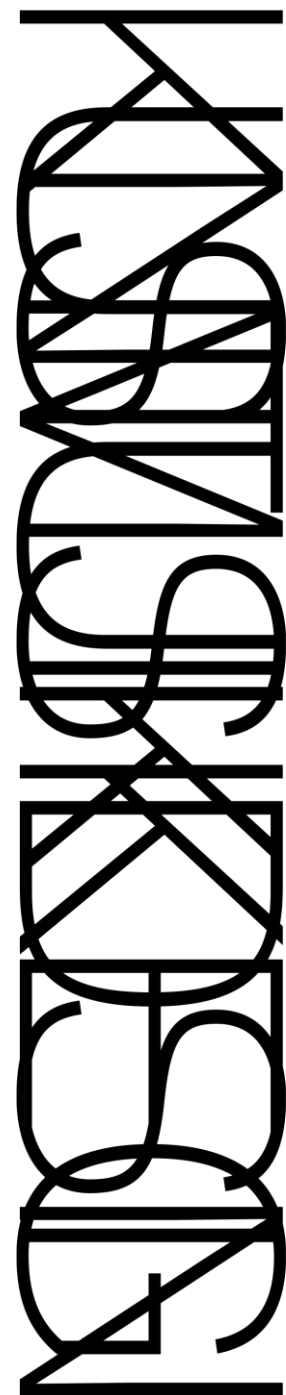
Timewise its not massive but continuous offer. Two half days with home work in between? (some more e.g. Writing and Methodology)

Standard tools for research ethics, such as RETTE and NSD, must be introduced.

The department leaders and research leaders need to be drivers and advisers, together with the research administration.

At least two from the research administration must be qualified and introduced as experts.

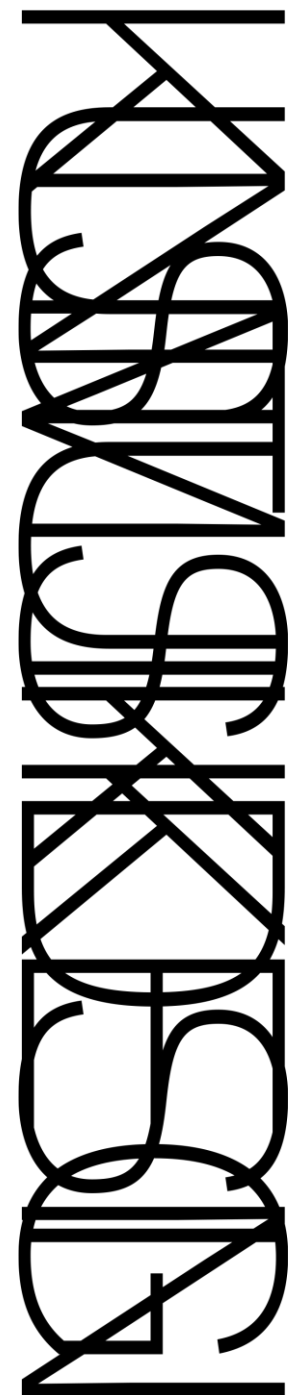
**For funded projects within the faculty, a checklist on ethical issues and a kickoff procedure concerning this should be worked out.** This also applies to PhD projects
