Model-data analyses using innovative approaches will be welcome.</li> <li>3- Improving estimates of climate change induced modifications of ocean physics and ocean chemistry, associated with biogeochemical cycles, including ocean acidification and carbon sequestration.</li> </ol> <p>Projects should involve partners from at least 3 of the supporting countries: Belgium, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Norway (more countries might join before the opening of the call)</p> <p>The application process is a one-stage submission process.</p>
