It is permitted to use 9-point font for the list of references and figure captions. The proposal must be written in English. You can delete this box when preparing the proposal. Proposals that lack requested information will not be handled further.

#### Please note: Information on the following must be included:

- 1. **Objectives and approach** in relation to the call and the current state-of-the art.
- 2. Research plan describing the planned research activities and methods in the project.
- **3.** Relevance and expected impact: How may the proposed project contribute to the chosen subject area under this call? What is the expected impact?
- **4.** The consortium and scientific leadership: Describe the consortium as a whole how will it match the project's objectives, and bring together necessary expertise and infrastructure? How will the scientific leadership be attended to, and how do the members complement each other with regards to competencies and available resources?

- A letter signed by the leader of the TRACE board, vice dean of research Marit Bakke, confirming that the proposed research is in line with the aims and scientific scope of the Centre.
