Employees at UiB can sign up for membership with the Sammen (Student Welfare Organisation's) sports facilities. Sammen organises special classes for UiB employees, and many of the activities are organised so that you can exercise immediately before or after work. In addition, the Student Welfare Organisation (Sammen) lets university employees who want to cycle, jog or walk to work use their changing rooms. Sammen has 20 cafées and coffeshops located on various campuses in Bergen, all with student and employee prices.
