Remember to become an online user!

An electronic ID is a proof of identity that confirms who you are. It's a quick, efficient, and safe way of getting access to online services from the state and the municipality, included information on your taxes like your tax card and your tax return. When you receive your Norwegian ID number, **remember to send it to** <u>post@lonnskontoret.uib.no</u>. This also applies when you receive your Norwegian bank account number.

Winter sports!

There are several ski areas within a few hours' drive of Bergen. The top 5 most popular skiing areas near Bergen are Eikedalen, Espedalen, Lifjell, Strandaand and Voss. It is also possible to do cross-country skiing closer to Bergen (when there is snow), such as Totland, Bontveit, Ulriken, Fløyen to mention a few. Need skiing equipment? This (and other sports equipment) can be rented at **BUA**.

Winter holidays

For those of you that have children in school, the winter holidays for schools in Bergen is from February 26th to March 1st. This does not include kindergarten and after-school care. Check what applies for your children's school or daycare.

Kindergarten application
