One of the highlights of May is the national holiday on the **17**<sup>th</sup>, which is celebrated all over the country with great pride and joy. It's a day when Norwegians honor their constitution, their history, and their culture, and it's a day that brings people together.

On this special day, you will see people in traditional costumes called **bunad**, or suits and dresses. It is customary to carry a Norwegian flag and wear red, white and blue ribbons.

There are also other holidays or "red days" you should know about this month:

May 1<sup>st</sup>: Labour Day
May 17<sup>th</sup>: Constitution Day
May 29<sup>th</sup>: Ascension Day
June 9<sup>th</sup>: Whit Monday

Many people will probably take days off this month to have longer weekends!
