Pre-arrival essentials: immigration, registration & tax in Norway

If you are relocating to Bergen, make sure to sign up and join us for an online informative meeting about immigration, the registration process with the Norwegian authorities and taxes in Norway.

We have this seminar **2 Fridays per month**, from **11.00** to **11.30**. The next seminar will be on November 15th. In the registration form you can choose which date you want to sign up to.

Orientation course for international employees

This course is the third step of our onboarding seminars for new international employees. The course will take place on **Thursday December 5**th from **13.00** to **15.30**. Get established in Bergen

Once you have had your meeting with the Tax Administration and/or police at SUA, it is important to make sure you have your name clearly marked on your mailbox to receive mail sent from them. If you have not heard from them within one month after your appointment, you may contact them directly.

Once you receive your ID number and access to the Self-Service Portal (DFØ), make sure to update your contact information, as well as your next-of-kin.

Make sure to always use your private email address when you contact public offices. This is to ensure that even when you leave UiB, you can receive important information from them.

Norwegian course

Application deadline for next semester is **November 28**th so remember to sign up before this. You can find more information here.

Once you sign up for the course, we highly encourage you to see it through. The course is usually fully booked, and it is not fair to UiB and other staff/students to take up the space if you do not plan to attempt to complete it.

Vaccinations

Everyone living in Norway can get the seasonal influenza vaccine. It is especially recommended for people with an increased risk of complications from influenza, but it is available to all. If you wish to take it, book an appointment at a pharmacy or contact your GP. If you don't know who your GP is, log into HelseNorge.no (or call them if you are not able to log in).

Sammen Training and Cafeterias

Employees at UiB can sign up for membership with the Sammen (Student Welfare Organisation's) sports facilities. Events in Bergen

Pepperkakebyen (Gingerbread Town)

November 18 – December 31 at Kode–Permanenten.

November 22 – December 22 at Festplassen.
