## Get established in Bergen

Once you have had your meeting with the Tax Administration and/or police at SUA, it is important to make sure you have your name clearly marked on your mailbox to receive mail sent from them. If you have not heard from them within one month after your appointment, you may contact them directly.

Once you receive your ID number and access to the Self-Service Portal (DFØ), make sure to update your contact information, as well as your next-of-kin.

To register your ID number and tax information at UiB, please send your ID number as soon as you receive it to the payroll office at **post@lonnskontoret.uib.no.** 

Make sure to always use your private email address when you contact public offices. This is to ensure that even when you leave UiB, you can receive important information from them.

If you move within Norway, or leave Norway, make sure to always update your address. For more information about arriving and establishing in Norway, please see our website for incoming staff.
